Time is flying by and Opening day will soon be here. Remember to pop down to the Club to pay your subs for the coming season when you can.

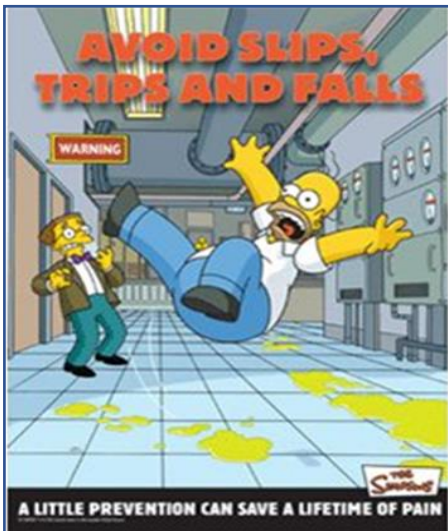
Thanks again to those of you who have already done so, that is much appreciated.

All You Need To Know>>

- **Mondays:** No bowls and no practice allowed – work will take place on the roof all day
- **Tuesdays:** Tournament as usual NO CHANGE – no work on the roof on these days
- **Wednesdays:** No bowls and no practice allowed – work will take place on the roof all day
- **Thursdays:** College bowls and green available for practice from 4pm
- **Fridays:** 2-4-2 tournament will start between 1-30pm – 2.00pm.
- **Saturdays:** Roll-up starts at 2pm
- **Sundays:** No change, available for practice as usual.
- The Club carpark will not be available.
- Members only have to sign in and out on non-bowling days i.e. Mondays - Wednesdays - Thursdays.
- The bar is open on these days plus the use of pool table or dart board are available. Contractors are working so members must always be indoors apart from leaving for home
- The days we play bowls, the contractors are not on site or have knocked off for the day.



HEALTH & SAFETY

While the work is taking place, you **MUST** be extra careful when moving around the Club. The Club is responsible for keeping everyone safe so watch your feet and be mindful of any potential hazards. If you see something or have a near miss, please let someone know so we can fix it **BEFORE** something happens.
